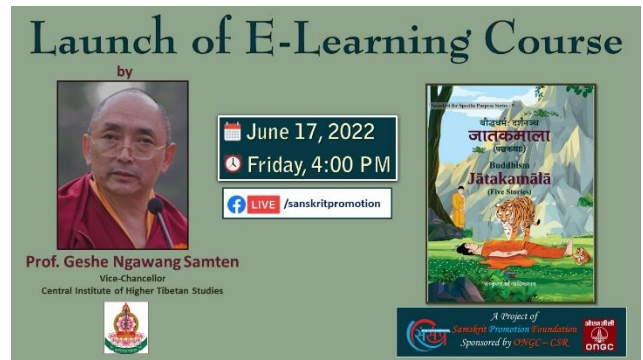



**Saṃskṛtasambhāṣaṇam** A structured course focused on conversational Sanskrit for practical fluency.

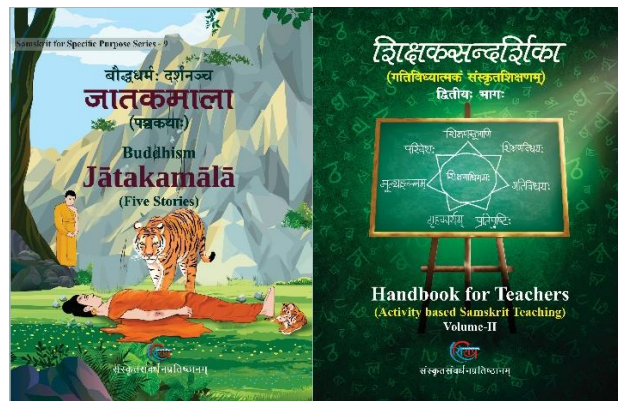
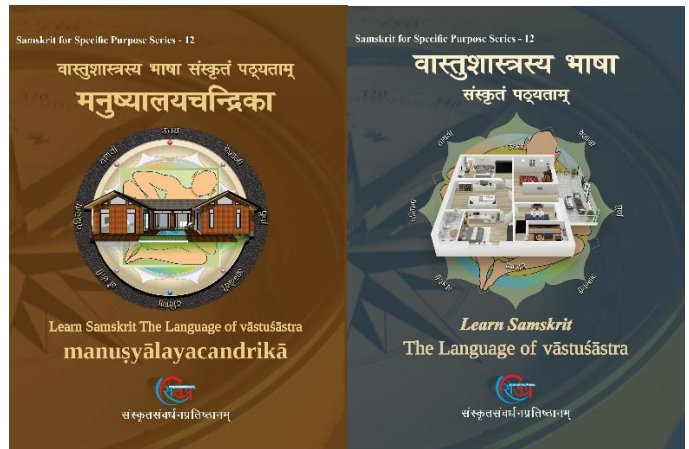
**Abhyāsasāriṇī** —
