

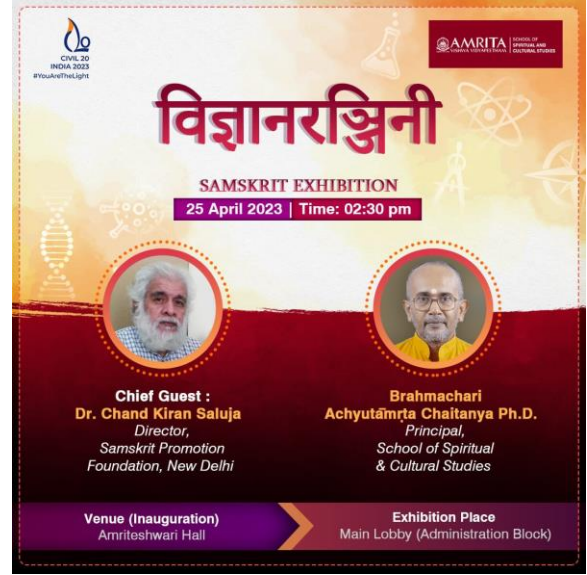

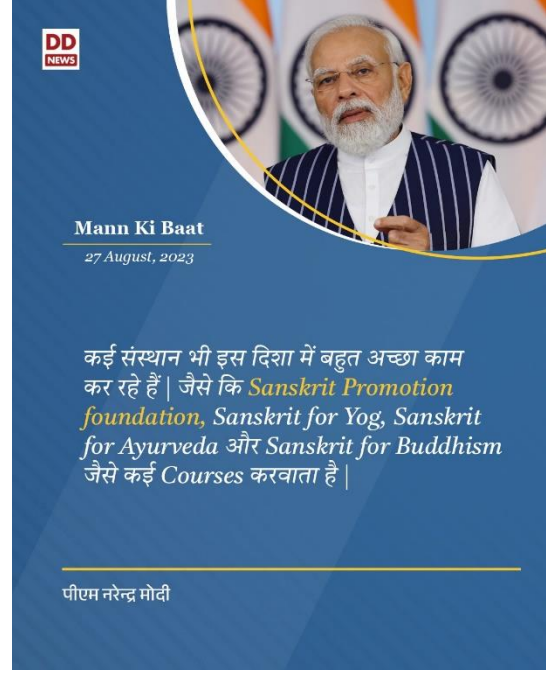
The exhibition offered attendees a glimpse into SPF's ongoing efforts to bridge classical wisdom with contemporary education, aligned with the vision of NEP 2020.
