Rail Vikas Nigam Limited, Delhi : In collaboration with Rail Vikas Nigam Limited (RVNL), Delhi, the Samskrit Promotion Foundation has undertaken a significant project (October 2024 – September 2025) for the preparation of Sanskrit-based learning materials in the Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) category. The project, valued at ₹98.5 lakh, reflects SPF's commitment to integrating Sanskrit into foundational education.



Teacher Training Program: Samskrit Promotion Foundation, in collaboration with **Uttarakhand Sanskrit Board**, conducted a **Teacher Training Program** for Sanskrit teachers of Uttarakhand in two batches, with **50 teachers per batch**.

- An **online teacher training program** was also organized, with **56 teachers completing the course** and **50 currently in progress**.
- A **Handbook on key topics** is under preparation to support the training initiative.
